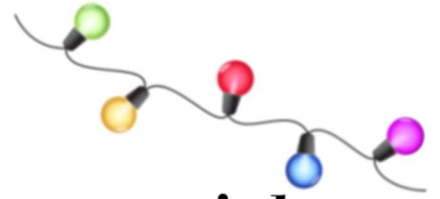


# the Blooming Carrot

## gift wrap guide



The keys to super cute, coordinated gift wrapping are **making a plan** and **shopping early!** Here are my tips...

### Tips

- Choose theme and/or colors ahead of time BEFORE you starting buying (ex: Buffalo plaid, evergreens, pink/red/white, black/white/red). Stick to a few colors (3-4) to avoid it getting too busy.
- Buy multiple paper rolls / bags when you find them
- SHOP EARLY so you can get multiples of the items you want!
- Mix up ribbons + bows. Lots of ideas in the Checklist below!
- Add embellishments for a special touch! Store-bought, premade or just go out in nature. Think candy canes, pinecones, greenery (faux or fresh), small ornaments, jingle bells, mini bottle brush trees!
